
Indiana School Choice Scholarship Program

Commonly referred to as "School Voucher Program"

Understanding how the Program can provide educational opportunities for your family.

In order to apply for the School Choice Scholarship Program, a family MUST meet certain requirements:

- 1. Be legal residents of Indiana
- 2. The student(s) must have been enrolled in an Indiana public school (grade 1 through 11) for the previous two (2) consecutive semesters
- 3. The student(s) must be between the ages of 5 and 22 no later than August 1 of the school year.
- 4. Have a total gross income and household size that qualify you for the Free and/or Reduced Lunch Program
- 5. Be admitted to a school based upon our admittance examinations and interviews.



Incoming Kindergarten or 1st grade determine if eligible for an SGO Scholarship

SGO Scholarship is a pre-cursor to the School Choice Scholarship Grants and is only available to families who will be enrolling a Kindergarten student or a First Grader (who attended Kindergarten in a public school). A \$300 credit can be given for tuition and the school will work with you to determine appropriate financial assistance. Each student will be eligible for the Indiana School Choice Scholarship Program for grades 2-12, should they meet eligibility requirements.
